


Meet Nicole

With options for both in-person and remote training, jobseekers can start today and get one step closer to their goals.

Information Technology (IT)

Goodwill Columbus offers free IT training and credentials, like CompTIA A+ and Google certifications, that are open to anyone interested in starting or growing a career in technology. Completing this course enables people to secure in-demand roles like IT support specialist, technical support analyst, or cyber security specialist.

Hospitality

This programming and coaching is for people looking to begin or expand a career in customer service.

A free, life-changing opportunity for young adults, ages 18-24, who are not currently enrolled in classes. In partnership with the Franklin County Department of Job and Family Services (JFS) & the Workforce Development Board of Central Ohio (WDBCO), Goodwill Columbus is proud to offer free specialized assistance and coaching to young Central Ohioans looking to make a positive change in their life.

Qualifications:

- Young adults, ages 18-24 years old
- Reside in Franklin County
- Not currently enrolled in classes
- Meets eligibility requirements

Digital Literacy

This program provides free training for anyone interested in expanding their digital skills for work and everyday life. Goodwill Columbus digital literacy classes, which take place across Franklin County and at many Columbus Metropolitan Library branches, teach computer basics, smartphone and tablet usage, internet safety, and more.

Healthcare

A career in healthcare is within reach with Goodwill Columbus' free job training and certification programs. People who complete our free, in-person courses can earn credentials for in-demand roles in areas like hands-on patient care, healthcare administration, and more.
